

## INFORMATION OBLIGATION

**You will find below all necessary information about EuroCert Sp. z o.o. with its registered office in Warsaw, 02-844, at ul. Puławska 474, KRS 0000408592**

Personal data provided by you are processed pursuant to Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (Official Journal of the European Union of 2016, No. 119, p. 1), hereinafter referred to as "GDPR".

We inform as follows:

1. **EuroCert Sp. z o.o. with its registered office in Warsaw, 02-844, at ul. Puławska 474, KRS 0000408592**, is the controller of your personal data provided in the form, hereinafter also referred to as the "Controller". The Controller will carry out processing of your personal data.

4. Your data will be shared with other recipients, including:

  - b) subcontractors cooperating with us on the basis of concluded agreements on entrusting the processing of personal data, providers of ICT services, providers of courier services, entities intermediating in the sale of our services or organization of our marketing campaigns, entities providing consulting, auditing, accounting, debt collection, legal assistance to us, entities conducting payment activities (banks, financial institutions), external providers of identity identification services, entities or authorities authorized by law (including courts, prosecutor's office, police).
  
5. You have the right to request the Controller to:
  - a) provide you with access to your personal data,
  - b) rectify your personal data,
  - c) delete your personal data (request to delete data will result in immediate deletion of your personal data from our database),
  - d) restrict processing of your personal data,
  - e) you may lodge a complaint with a supervisory body,
  - f) transfer your data,
  - g) you may withdraw consent to the processing of your personal data at any time. Withdrawal of consent will not affect the lawfulness of the processing which was carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal,
  - h) you may object to the processing of personal data – if the processing is necessary to perform a task carried out in the public interest or as part of the exercise of public authority entrusted to the Controller, and if the processing is necessary for purposes arising from legitimate interests pursued by the Controller or by a third party, including in the case of profiling. The Controller will no longer be allowed to process such personal data, unless he demonstrates existence of valid legitimate grounds for the processing, overriding interests, rights and freedoms of the data subject, or grounds for establishing, investigating or defending claims.
